English

Our learning will be focussed on the books Where the Poppies Now Grow by Hilary Robinson and Traction Man by Mini Grey.

You could help your child at home by:

Talking to them about Remembrance Day and why we have the poppy.

Sharing the countries people in your family have been to and showing children where this is on a world map. Children could track places where mums or dads have been deployed.

Talking to your child about their favourite teddy or toy. They could make up their own adventure for them.

Maths

Some of the things that we will be exploring include:

- Addition and Subtraction
- Money

You could help your child at home by:

- Practicing adding and subtracting when playing board games, dice games or out shopping.
- Practicing counting games forwards and backwards in different steps.
- Logging onto your Numbots account and practicing your number skills.
- Handling money when shopping. Perhaps they could have pocket money to spend!
