GOVERNORS' STAFFING COMMITTEE

MEMBERSHIP AND MEETINGS

The committee shall meet at least once a term. It shall consist of seven governors including the Headteacher. Three governors shall comprise a quorum.

TERMS OF REFERENCE

The committee has the following responsibilities:

- 1. To draw up a shadow staffing structure and regularly review existing staffing against it
- 2. To carry out an annual review of staffing, including a review of the salaries of teaching and non-teaching staff, and to submit recommendations as necessary on staff numbers (both teaching and non-teaching), salary scales and allowances.
- 3. To monitor the deployment of supply teachers, students, temporary staff and ancillary staff (delegate to the Headteacher).
- 4. To make all necessary arrangements for the appointment of the Headteacher and the Deputy/Assistant Headteacher by the governing body.
- 5. To arrange, when necessary, an Appointments Panel of at least two governors and the Headteacher to deal with the appointment of a teacher and for any disciplinary hearings.
- 6. To show concern for all staff and their welfare and to follow, where necessary, laid down grievance procedures relating to their employment and disciplinary matters.
- 7. To maintain an overview of the process of Teacher Appraisal and to review the performance of the Head Teacher alongside an external advisor.
- 8. To consider applications from all staff for flexible working arrangements in line with local and national policy.
