We held a circus day and practised performing different circus acts including plate spinning, juggling, and walking on a beam.

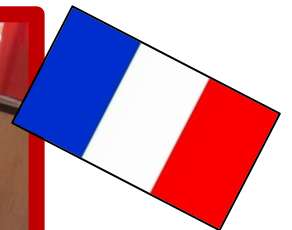


We learnt about different places of worship and ended the half-term with a visit to Thorney Island Church to meet the Padre.

Summer Term

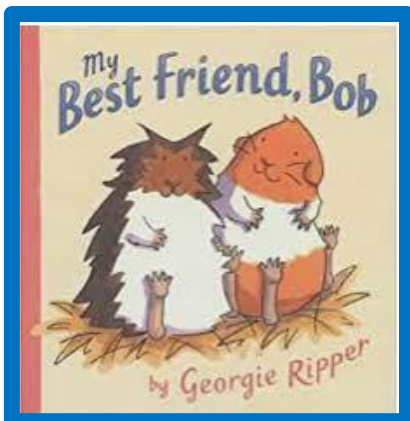


This term we went on safari to the Animal Kingdom to learn all about different animals and their habitats.

We listened to their special story and learnt how to keep all our pets happy and healthy.

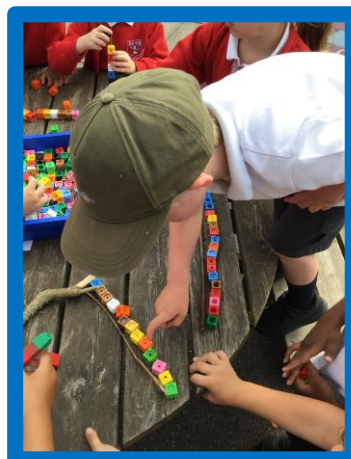
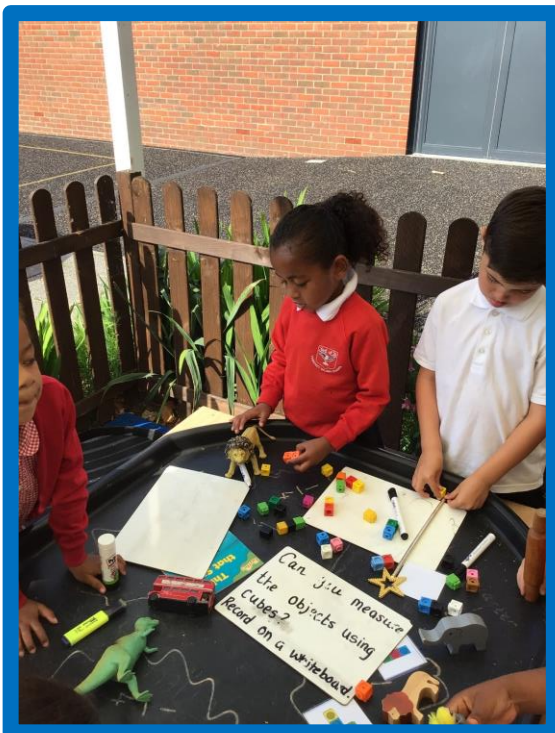




We made our own animals from clay
