Spring Term



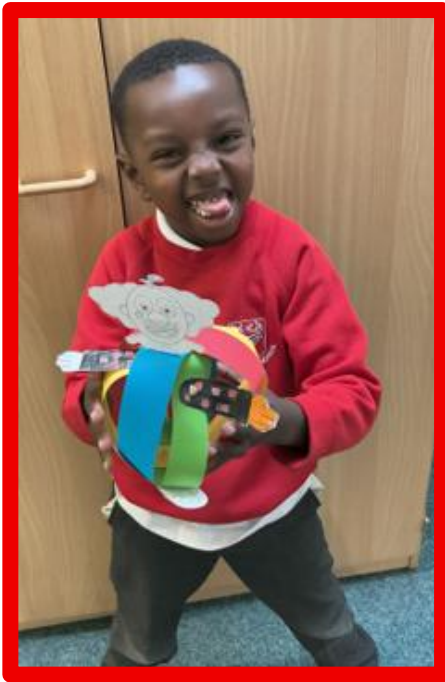
This term the circus came to town!

We made a circus themed display and dressed up to look like circus performers.

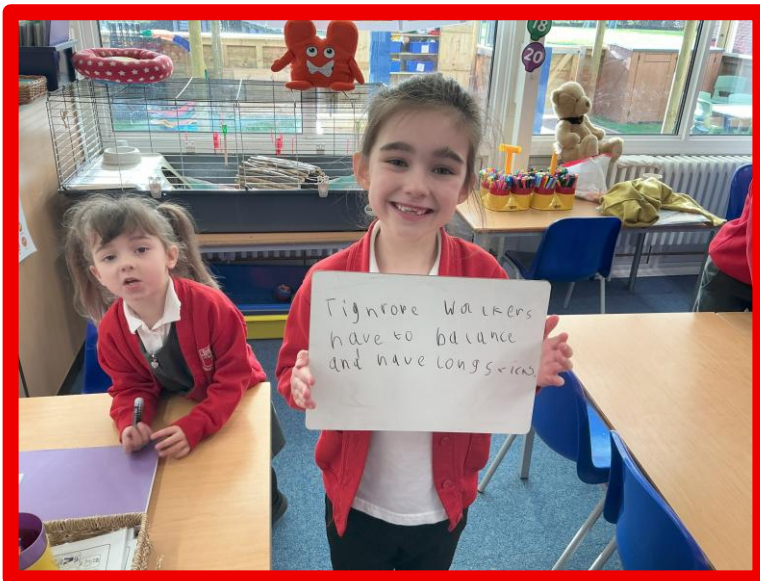


We held a circus day and practised performing different circus acts including plate spinning, juggling, and walking on a beam.

our writing...

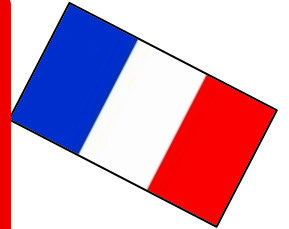
...and our maths.

Summer Term

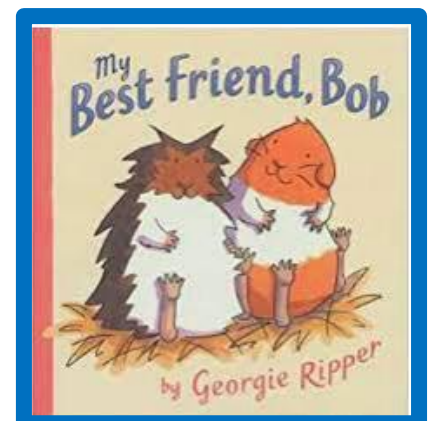


This term we went on safari to the Animal Kingdom to learn all about different animals and their habitats.
