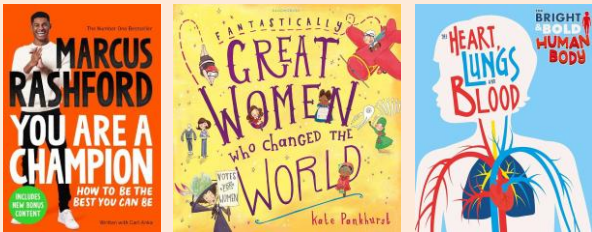
Dear Parents & Carers,

English



We will be writing for a range of purposes this half term, applying everything we have learnt throughout Key Stage 2. We will be writing biographies about inspiring people, taking ideas on layout and key features from the book 'Fantastically Great Women Who Changed the World.' We will then be creating persuasive adverts for our fundraising project before creating and performing some poetry for our leavers assembly. In guided reading we will be reading 'You Are a Champion' by Marcus Rashford: a positive and inspiring book which will encourage us to pursue our dreams!

Continuing to encourage your child to read, and research an inspirational person such as an entrepreneur that has made a success of their life from humble beginnings.

Maths

This half term we will be revising some previously taught concepts and applying a range of maths knowledge to real-life and purposeful projects such as our charity project where we will use the skills of statistics, adding and subtracting money and budgeting.

PE

This half term includes lots of opportunities for the class to participate in a range of sporting events. Alongside our PE lessons, which will continue to take place on a Wednesday and Friday, we will be preparing for events such as: Sports Day, Area Athletics, Sports Week, and the notoriously competitive Year 6 vs Staff rounders match!

PSHE

In PSHE lessons this half term, we will be learning and having discussions about change. This includes changes during puberty and changes in the year ahead.

Science

In our science lessons this half term, we will be learning about light and how it travels. We will investigate how light moves, how shadows are formed and how we see objects. In addition to this, we will learn more about reflection and how light helps us in everyday life.

RE

RE will be taught by Mrs Bramall. RE lessons will focus on humanist beliefs and the impact of religion on people's lives and communities.

Homework

For the final half term, we will return to our successful 'Homework Menu' format. Tasks centre around fundraising and memories of Thorney Island Primary.

Computing

This half term, we are going to become website creators. Using Google Sites, we will create websites to raise awareness of a local cause. We will be considering the layout, font, and pictures to make it eye catching.

Our art lessons this half term will focus on photography. We will explore the work of a photographer called Hugo Suissas, who uses perspective and creative angles to create interesting and original photos.
