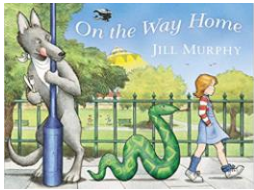
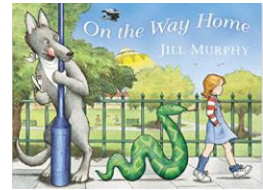




# CREATURE FEATURES

### Maths

Some of the things we will be exploring include:

- Statistics, tables and charts
- Position and direction (left, right, forwards, backwards etc)
- Introducing the column method for addition and subtraction
- Lots of practical application involving weight, volume and capacity

You could help your child at home by:

Continuing to practice time tables with your child.

Discussing how we measure different things - talk about measurements on food packaging and compare different objects weights and heights.

Completing activities on Numbots.

### English

We will be looking at the book "On the Way Home by Jill Murphy and inventing our own imaginary stories about our journey round Thorney Island.

You could help your child at home by:

Reading on the Way Home by Jill Murphy and discussing the story. *Good read aloud examples of these books can be found on YouTube.*

Taking your child for a walk round Thorney Island discussing the different locations their history and what magical creatures could live there (the crazier the better. Think dragons, goblins and trolls).

### Geography

In Geography we will be looking at map skills and aerial photographs of Thorney Island. It would be useful if your child could have some knowledge of how to use an atlas and the four compass points.

### Science

In Science this half term we will be learning about animals and their habitats. Thinking about some of the ways these amazing animals have adapted to where they live.
