Maths

This half term we will be covering:

- Place value (numbers to 10 million).
- Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division
- Factors, multiples and prime numbers
- Converting units of measure

Science

In Science this half term we will be learning about the circulatory system and reminding ourselves of how to maintain a healthy lifestyle, through diet, exercise and making the right choices.

English

This half term we will be writing suspense stories around the idea of surviving a volcanic eruption! Using inspiration from the text 'Survivor: Escape from Vesuvius' By Jim Eldridge. We will be producing some persuasive writing – to persuade people to live near a volcano and writing some information texts about the Romans

Encourage your child to explore their interests by researching a specific aspect of Roman life, and help them find engaging information books on the topic.

History - The Romans

We will be looking at how Mount Vesuvius erupted and buried the ancient city of Pompeii and how the findings helped historians gain a clearer understanding of the Romans. We will also look at how the Romans settled in Britain, who their enemies were and how they defended themselves, as well the many inventions which have changed the way we live today.



Homework and Spellings

This half term's homework will follow the same format as in Year 5 and a 'Homework Menu' will be sent home with your child with a choice of tasks to complete over the half term. As well as these tasks, please read with your child daily

(or encourage your child to read to themselves) and practise minute games and spellings.

Spellings will be sent home

(and added to Spelling Frame) every Friday and tested the following Thursday.

We will also be learning about volcanoes in our Geography lessons, creating some inky artwork, preparing for a Roman banquet and learning some new French words!
